Background information

Our first mission trips were done during the communist regime of Ceaucescu. As a foreign team it was not difficult to visit persecuted Christians, and even to help them with clothes, medicines, food and money. Individuals trying to help persecuted Christians, were often stopped and things they had with them were confiscated. Forming a larger group made it much easier, especially as the communists realized the economic importance of these groups of 'tourists'.

The revolution in 1989 brought freedom in the country but didn't close the gap between rich and poor. Romania still suffers from a lot of problems, parents who leave their children on the streets or in orphanages, landlords who force families out of their houses as they are unable to pay the rent or the bills. Salaries are still very low, and social benefits are insufficient by any standards. Families struggle to buy even the basics as food and clothing. Even though education is free, many families can't afford the school materials and for that reason leave their children at home instead of sending them to school. The



Child Sponsor Programme supports many families, and the waiting list is growing.

Eastern European Outreach continued the larger group trips, so that in one-week time many families and institutions can be visited, so many people can receive help, but more important personal contact.

Goal

The goal of the group trip is to encourage the poor and being a blessing for our brothers and sisters in the Lord, this is achieved by the traveller being there, and also by handing out food parcels and clothes. The team will visit families, EEO projects, prisons, Roma gypsy camps and churches. It is important to help the poor materially, but we want to emphasise that without spiritual encouragement and personal contact this is not lasting. That is why evangelism, singing of worshipsongs and hymns and giving testimony are such an important part of the programme. The programme is prepared by EEO Intl. in co-operation with local contact persons.

Teams, Team leaders and special visits

Every day will have a day opening and a day closure meeting, team members will be encouraged to take part, and may even lead the meeting. We also like to know if you are playing a musical instrument. As much as possible we try to plan in personal visit requests from participants, for example if they want to visit their sponsor child.
